### **RULES AND STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR LEGAL GUARDIAN OR AUTHORIZED ADULT:**

- Deliver child in a timely manner. Sessions begin promptly at 9:00 am. Please arrive 15 minutes early to sign child in.
- Child to be released to a legal guardian or listed authorized adult at noon; but no later than 12:15 pm.
- When Minor Child is dropped off and picked up, an authorized adult must come into the Sunday School building on the Church premises and sign them in and out. Adult must show i.d. when picking up if not known to the staff. Children will not be allowed to leave without authorized adult to sign them out. Your Child's safety is most important to us.
- Child's legal guardian must provide a *COMPLETED* and *SIGNED* registration / indemnification form and pay all required fees prior to each child's participation.
- Child's legal guardian must provide in writing any special or medical needs of the child on the registration form.
- The Bible Discovery Camp officially begins and ends at the First Church of Christ, Scientist, Santa Barbara in its Sunday School building. The Child's legal guardian is responsible for all transportation to and from the event.
- Child must be toilet trained in order to participate. Please provide an adequate change of garments for child if you think there may be a need.
- Guardian must dress child appropriately each day for the weather. Please provide a sweatshirt or light jacket, a hat, and apply sunscreen as some activities will be outside.

- Child must wear or bring footwear that has an enclosed toe, like running shoes, as some activities will be outside on hard surfaces.
- Please mark all personal items with the child's name written in permanent ink. BDC provides a lost and found but is not responsible for lost, forgotten or stolen items.
- By signing the Registration Form you and your child agree to comply with the Rules and Standards of Conduct.

## **RULES AND STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR CAMPERS:**

- Child is expected to participate in a friendly manner.
- Child is expected to stay with their assigned group and follow directions.
- Use an "inside voice" when indoors.
- Be kind to staff and other campers.
- Child is expected to wait with the BDC attendant until their legal guardian or authorized adult signs them out at pick-up.
- Participation is at the discretion of the BDC leader.
